Requirements for perc testing 4 or more areas/lots

DATE:

Revised February 21, 2007, REVISED May 24, 2022

Effective this date, land owners/developers applying for perc tests for **4 or more areas/lots** must provide the following prior to the date of the perc tests:

Concept Plan Requirements (prepared by a licensed Maryland surveyor)

- ❖ Topography must be shown in 5 foot minimum contours, 2 foot preferred.
- Scale can be 1"=200' if 25% slopes are identified; otherwise, at least 1" = 100'.
- Show proposed lot lines with proposed lot numbers.
- ❖ Show three proposed perc test locations approximately 75 feet apart and labeled with lot number (if subdividing) and A, B, C.
- ❖ Show C hole at lowest elevation water table hole.
- Show any existing landmarks, i.e. treelines, barns, existing dwellings, etc.

Field Staking Requirements

Only proposed perc test locations with corresponding labels need to be staked.
